PERI Damage Waiver Policy

Policy summary

Our aim is to make construction more efficient from start to finish. This means reducing the time it takes to process returns and close off projects, so you can move on to your next project swiftly.

Our Damage Waiver Policy has been created to give you peace of mind when returning rental equipment.

Our products are made from high-quality materials, meaning they can be used time and time again. However, we know that wear and tear and minor damages can occur due to regular and intended use throughout your project's duration. With maintenance and repair, we can extend the service life of these products so they can be reused in the future.

What does this mean for me?

We'll apply a monthly levy of 2.5% of your total hire charge to cover you for wear and tear, cleaning, and repair charges during your rental period. This will enable us to continue offering you a high standard of rental equipment for every project.

With the Damage Waiver included as part of your rental agreement, there are no unexpected costs at the end of your rental period. The table on the next page will tell you what type of damage the policy covers you for.



Preventing damages

All of our products come with an Instructions for Assembly and Use guide to help you use them safely, efficiently and to reduce the risk of damage. You can download this guide from our website or request a copy from your Sales Engineer.

What the policy does not cover you for

This policy does not cover you for any damages or repairs as a result of force majeure events or blatant misuse and abuse of our equipment. In these instances, you may incur additional charges to cover the cost of the damage. To find out what you are covered for, see the table to the right.
